

GENERAL INFORMATION

We are looking forward to your attendance at the **2016 Colorado Association of Conservation District's Camp Rocky - Outdoor Environmental Adventures**. Please plan to arrive at the camp between 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 10; plan to leave at 9:00 a.m. the following Saturday, July 16th.

In order to attend the camp, we must have the following documents on file at the CACD office by **July 1, 2016**.

- **Application for Camp Rocky**
- **Camper Health Information**
- **Camper Information**
- **Camp Rules**
- **Release of Liability**

The altitude at the camp is over 9,500 feet. Each mountain day provides a sample of the seasons - spring in the morning, summer in the afternoon, fall in the evening, and sometimes snow in June. The weather can change suddenly, so *please* come prepared with adequate clothing.

Meals will be provided in the main dining hall and *all* campers are required to be present during meals.

Sleeping facilities are rustic cabins with bunk beds. **You are responsible for bringing your own sleeping bag.** Night temperatures can be very cool, so bring good quality bedding.

Please label items that are considered of special value so that others do not inadvertently pick them up.

Also, bring necessary personal health supplies. There is a nurse on the camp staff to dispense all medications to participants. If you have *any special needs*, please inform staff upon arrival.

NECESSARY ITEMS TO BRING

Adequate clothing, including sweater and jacket	Hiking shoes or boots (closed toe shoes)
Warm sleeping bag, pillow and warm pajamas	Sunscreen and chapstick
Water repellent footwear and rain gear, hat	Notebook and pencils

NOTE TO PARENTS: Directions to Camp: at the Divide stoplight (about 25 miles west of Colorado Springs on US Hwy 24) turn south on Colorado Hwy 67 and watch for the camp sign (about four miles south of Divide), then turn left on County Road 62 and it is about 1.5 miles to the camp.
