

## **2020 CAMP ROCKY GENERAL INFORMATION**

**We are looking forward to your attendance at this year's Colorado Association of Conservation District's (CACD) 2020 Camp Rocky - outdoor natural resource conservation educational adventure. Please plan to arrive at the camp between 2:00 and 3:00PM on Sunday, July 5th, and plan to be picked up at 9:00 AM the following Saturday, July 11th.**

**In order to attend the camp, CACD must have the following documents to our office by **June 15, 2020:****

- **Application for Camp Rocky**
- **Camper Health Information**
- **Camper Information**
- **Medical Administration**
- **Form Camp Rules**
- **Release of Liability**

The altitude at Camp Rocky is over 9,500 feet. Each mountain day provides a sample of the seasons - spring in the morning, summer in the afternoon, fall in the evening, and sometimes snow in June. The weather can change suddenly, **so please come prepared with adequate clothing.**

Meals will be provided in a Dining Hall setting and all campers are required to be present during meals.

Sleeping facilities are rustic cabins with bunk beds. **You are responsible for bringing your own sleeping bag, blankets, and pillows.** Night temperatures can be very cool, so bring good quality bedding.

Please label items that are considered of special value so that others do not inadvertently pick them up.

**There is a camp nurse on staff to dispense all medications to participants. If you have any special needs, please inform staff you're your arrival.**

### **NECESSARY ITEMS TO BRING:**

Adequate clothing--including sweatshirts and jackets, hiking shoes or boots (closed toe);

Warm sleeping bag, pillow, warm pajamas, socks, flashlight;

Sunscreen, lip balm, hat, sunglasses, work gloves, water bottle, notebook, pencils;

Water repellent footwear (optional) and rain gear;

Soap, shampoo, toothbrush and tooth paste, towels/washcloths, deodorant, etc.;

Money for Camp snack bar purchases.

**OPTIONAL ITEMS TO BRING:**

Small backpack, binoculars, camera, deck of cards, Talent Show items.

**DO NOT BRING RADIOS, ANT ELECTRONIC DEVICES, I-PODS, TABLETS!!!  
IN CASE OF EMERGENCY:**

**RMMC DIRECTIONS:**

Camp Rocky is held at the Rocky Mountain Mennonite camp facility, just south of Divide, Colorado, on Highway 67. In Divide, at the CO Highway 24 and 67 stoplight (about 25 miles west of Colorado Springs), turn south on Hwy 67. Proceed south about 4.5 miles and watch for the Camp Rocky sign on your left. Turn left on County Road 62 and travel up the steep dirt road approximately 1.5 miles to camp. You will check in in the Dining Hall facility.
